

Regents Approve Contract for Ray Anderson as ASU Athletic Director

Anderson has served as executive vice president of football operations for the NFL since February 2007. Prior to joining the NFL, Anderson spent four seasons as executive vice president and chief administrative officer of the Atlanta Falcons. Before taking the job with the Falcons, Anderson represented a number of NFL players and coaches as a sports agent.

Anderson began his professional career as an attorney at Kilpatrick & Cody in Atlanta, working primarily in labor law litigation. Anderson later founded the sports law practice at the law firm of Heller Ehrman and, in 1987, launched a sports agency specializing in the representation of NFL coaches and players. Anderson was a three-year football letterman and two-year baseball letterman at Stanford University. He earned a BA in political science from Stanford in 1976 and a law degree from Harvard Law School in 1979.
